

All NSH Outpatient Imaging Facilities offer:

- General X-Rays for children of all ages (birth – 21 years of age)
- Non-contrasted CT and MRI procedures for children of all ages (birth – 21 years of age), if able to cooperate for the procedure and contrast is not medically necessary
- Contrasted CT and MRI procedures for children 13 years old and older
- Ultrasound (excluding pyloric stenosis, brains, spines, infant hips and malrotation)
- Upper GI examinations from birth – 21 years of age
- Select Nuclear Medicine procedures for children 13 years old and older following consultation with a radiologist

As always, there may be unusual circumstances and exceptions will be considered following consultation with a radiologist. The Northside Hospital Centralized Scheduling Department will assist you as these circumstances arise.

Centralized Scheduling

The Northside Hospital Centralized Radiology Scheduling Department will assist by directing your patient to the closest facility equipped with the modality required and is pleased to provide precertification services to physician offices for exams requiring prior authorization. **To schedule an appointment, call (404) 851 – 6577.**

With a focus on patient and physician needs, Northside offers quick appointments at many convenient locations located throughout metro Atlanta.

Business hours are from 8:15 a.m. until 4:45 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Immediately following an imaging study, patients can get their films on a compact disc (CD) free of charge. Northside strives to provide quick results/report turn around times with a key performance goal of eight hours for routine requests. Stat requests are available within an hour and stat preliminary reports are called immediately. You can also choose to have results auto faxed upon completion directly to your office.
